This piece entitled 'Hegarty wins Boston Trip at Ballyshannon' appeared in the Donegal Democrat dated 05th October 1984

One of the big prizes on offer at the 10th annual 'Ballyshannon 10 Mile Road Race' on Sunday, a trip to Boston for the first man and woman (sponsored by Eddie Barron, Boston, who is a native of Ballyshannon and who was home this year to present both prizes, stayed in the county as Finn Valley's Pat Hegarty ran a superb race to lead the field home in a time of 51.53, thus earning himself a chance to run in next years famous Boston Marathon.



The ladies race was won by Catherine Rooney, a native of Grange, County Sligo, running with Blackrock AC in Dublin. She finished 49th overall in a time of 59.27. She will go to Boston to compete in next years prestigious all female event, the 'Bonne Belle 10k' race.

Unlike the last few years, this years race was blessed with fine weather although the numbers taking part were

down nearly 100 on last year. Around 200 faced the starter. Ballyshannon Town Commissioner's Chairman, Anthony O'Malley Daly, on the Donegal Road, and 1855 of them successfully completed the tough figure of eight course. Higgindtown Hill, the graveyard of many runner's hopes of recording a good time.

Pat Hegarty however showed no fear of the course from the start. At an early stage a group of about a dozed, including Hegarty as well a fellow Donegal man Paddy O'Donnell [Killybegs] and Michael Crampsie, now Finn Valley, broke away.

The first mile was completed in 4.50 and then Hegarty upped the pace with John McDowell of Sparta, going through the second mile in 4.40. As the runners came onto the Rossnowlagh Road nearly the end of the third mile. Hegarty and McDowell had opened up a gap of about 20m with Michael Crampsie in third place and Paddy O'Donnell falling back.

Hegarty and McDowell were still together when they came back into town and through the 4 mile mark but then started up the Higginstown Road Hegarty really go dug in. At half was he had opened up a gap, which by the time they had reached the top of the hill, a mile further on had grown to 50m. The hill had obviously taken its toll on McDowell as Hegarty began to stretch the lead to 100m between 6 and 7 miles. King of the hill however was Paddy O'Donnell who moved up from 6th going through the town in 3rd, just 50m behind McDowell, at the top of the hill.

Between 7 and 8 niles Hegarty seemed to get a stitch and looked to be in trouble as he slowed and McDowell

closed the gap to about 30m. However the Donegal man began to recover over the next mile and by the time they reached the last mile on the Bundoran Road had got back into his stride. In the end he had 7 seconds to spare over McDowell with Paddy O'Donnell a further 48 seconds back in third place.

Michael Crampsie who fell away a bit after a good start finished 4th, i minute and 23 seconds behind O'Donnell.

In the ladies race, Catherine Rooney [59.27] and Moira O'Boyle [60.47] of Belfast had a great battle, they were locked together up until the half way mark and them Rooney took over going up the hill, she was a minute and 20 seconds ahead of O'Boyle at the finish. Finn Valley's Kay McGowan was third lady home in a time of 61.58.

The team race was won by Sparta,
Derry with 35 points. Finn Valley were
2nd with 46 points and Sligo AC 3rd
with 59 points. The scoring members
of the Finn Valley Team were Pat
Hegarty (1st), Michael Crampsie (4th),
Eddie McMenamin (19th) and Patsy
Doherty (22nd).

The mens veteran race was won by Philip McGuinness of Sligo AC and the youth U-19 race won by Sligo runner Michael Casey, with Paul McNulty of Finn Valley finishing third in that section.

Helena McKinney of Carndonagh won the girl's U-19 event with Philomena Gallagher of South Donegal Harriers and Ballyshannon second.

Pat Hegarty also won the Frank Cassidy Memorial Trophy for the first Donegal man home.

Pat Hegarty s win of the Ballyshannon '10' last Sunday was the most popular ever by any winner. To athletes generally in Donegal it was the next best thing to winning it themselves. More people wanted to shake Hegarty's hand in the hour after the race than would have been the case with the combination of all the winners here over the years. So well done to the most unassuming athlete and his coach Patsy McGonagle from Finn Valley. Pat Hegarty goes to the 'Boston Marathon' in April 85, while the ladies winner Catherine Rooney goes to the 'Bonne Belle 10k' also in Boston in October '85. Catherine is from Grange, County Sligo, works in Dublin and is a member of Blackrock AC. She had a battle all the way with Moira O'Boyle from Belfast before coming home stronger over the last two miles.

It was not one of the better South Donegal Team performances. The potential 'A' Team was more or less totally sidelined due to injury. The team on duty did their best, some of them even running above expectations. This was especially trus of younger athletes like Barry Fanon (65.53) and Joe Duffy (66.23). Sean Keenaghan was the first South Donegal Harrier man home in 61.13, still outside that elusive 60 minutes, but a strong run nonetheless. In addition to running Sean had all the worries of race director on his shoulders. That the race went of without a hitch bears testimony to the work done by Sean and the hard working committee over the last few months.
